### **What to do if you have been sexually assaulted:**

- Call the police if you are in immediate danger 610-399-2405 or 911
- Get to a safe place
- Call someone you trust
- Seek medical attention
- Preserve evidence: do not bathe/shower, eat/drink, smoke, brush your teeth or hair, urinate or wash your clothing (put your clothes in a paper—not plastic—bag)
- Report the assault promptly
- Talk with a counselor
- Take care of yourself

### **Safety tips**

- Don't think it can't happen to you
- You have the right to set sexual limits in any situation
- Don't be afraid to be assertive
- Consider taking a self-defense course offered by Cheyney Police Department every semester
- Trust your instincts
- Stay sober

### **Examples of when you are required to report**

- When a student tell you that he/she was the object of sexual harassment/assault or other crime (under mandatory reporter obligations) while a student at Cheyney
- When a student tells you that he/she committed an act of sexual harassment or assault or other crime (under mandatory reporter obligations) while a student at Cheyney

**Remember: if you see something, say something!**
